



Office and Financial Policy

Thank you for choosing Lifetime Dental as your dental care provider. We are committed to providing you the best dentistry has to offer. The following is a statement of our Financial Policy.

Lifetime Dental accepts assignment of insurance and participates with many dental insurances. Your insurance policy is between you and your insurance company. Lifetime Dental will help process claims with your insurance company on your behalf. We will also provide an estimate on your out-of-pocket copay for procedures. The estimate is not a guarantee and is based on what your insurance company states they will cover. You are responsible for any balances that your insurance company fails to cover.

Financial:

1. Payments are due at the time of service. We accept cash, credit cards, Care Credit and Health savings account cards.
2. All estimated co-pays and deductibles are due at the time of service.
3. Any payments including Personal Checks that are "bounced" or returned as NSF will incur a \$65 charge.

Appointments:

If you arrive more than 15 minutes after your appointment time, we may need to reschedule your appointment and consider it missed. Your appointment time is reserved especially for you. We ask that you give us a 48-business hour notice (2 Business Days) if you need to cancel or reschedule your appointment.

Failure to give us a 48-business hour notice will result in a \$50 charge to your account.
